

Leeds Town Hall, formerly known as Leeds School, is located on the beautiful Empire Prairie. A very convenient drive from Madison, Columbus, Portage and Lodi, the Leeds Town Hall is located at N1485 Pribbenow Drive, Arlington, WI 53911-9752.



From Madison, take US Hwy 51 North approx. 15 miles to the intersection of State Hwys 22 and 60. Go East on Hwy 60 approx. 1 mile. The Town Hall is on the right, just before the intersection with Harvey Road.

Located in a wooded country setting with ample parking, the building and grounds of the Leeds Town Hall are beautifully maintained. The park-like setting is ideal for outdoor activities and events. Playground equipment is available for your use.







In 2004, the Town of Leeds purchased Leeds School from the DeForest School District. Residents approved funding to completely renovate the fortress-like structure, making it a beautiful place for community, business or private events. The Town Hall easily accommodates groups of every size, and comes equipped with many convenient amenities.

On the main level, the Large Meeting Room easily accommodates groups of up to 250. This room includes a beautifully appointed kitchen area, which includes a large island with ample electrical outlets for serving food.

Large windows overlook the beautiful park-like setting of the grounds and playground area.
